Camille Bonenfant-Jeanneney joins the Eiffage group on 2 January 2025, where she will succeed Philippe Nourry, Chairman of Motorway Concessions, from 25 February 2025

Camille Bonenfant-Jeanneney is to join the Eiffage group on 2 January 2025, working alongside Philippe Nourry, Chairman of Eiffage Motorway Concessions in France, who is retiring on 28 February 2025.

Having held the role since April 2011, Philippe Nourry will hand over to Camille Bonenfant-Jeanneney on 25 February 2025. She will join the Executive Committee in this capacity.

Camille Bonenfant-Jeanneney is a graduate of the École Polytechnique (X2000), the École des Ponts ParisTech, and Sciences Po Paris. She began her career in 2006, working in European affairs as a diplomat with an industrial and environmental issues brief at the French Permanent Representation to the European Union. In 2012, she was appointed as an advisor to the Minister for European Affairs. In 2013, she joined RATP to lead the Grand Paris project before becoming Chief of Staff to the Chairman and CEO. In 2015, she joined the Engie group as part of its General Secretariat. She assumed leadership of the Parisian Urban Heating Company in 2018, then took over as CEO of Storengy in 2021. Since July 2023, she has been CEO of Engie Renewable Gas Europe. She was also an independent director of Autoroutes et Tunnel du Mont Blanc from 2019 to 2024.
