Eiffage Énergie Systèmes and Sunrock form a partnership to install four solar power systems in France

<u>Eiffage Énergie Systèmes</u>, a leader in the design, construction and maintenance of electrical, industrial and climate systems and facilities, and <u>Sunrock</u>, the European solar farm developer and operator specialised in the logistics sector, have announced the signing of four strategic contracts for the installation of solar power plants on logistics buildings. The facilities, with an installed capacity of of 12.5 MWp, will be located in four regions: Bourgogne, Île-de-France, Centre-Val de Loire and Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur. This partnership aims to develop large-scale solar projects designed to promote the consumption of local, low-carbon energy and reinject surplus energy into the network to boost sustainable energy production.

An alliance to consolidate renewable energy production

In combining their respective expertise, Eiffage Énergie Systèmes and Sunrock aim to accelerate the energy transformation in logistics infrastructure. The four new confirmed projects will create 60,000 m² of solar panels on 130,000 m² of logistics building roof surfaces, for an installed capacity of 12.5 MWp.

Maarten de Haas, CEO of Sunrock France, says:

"Sunrock is the energy partner for the owners of logistics and industrial assets across Europe. This collaboration with Eiffage Énergie Systèmes marks a key step in our development strategy in France. By joining forces with a recognised player in the sector, we are strengthening our capacity to deliver ambitious solar projects that address current environmental and energy challenges."

Real-world projects to deliver low-carbon energy

The four contracts signed cover strategic sites where the solar energy produced will directly supply local consumption needs and the wider electricity network. This programme is fully in line with the ambitions of the two companies to accelerate the energy transition and provide concrete solutions for decarbonisation.

For these turnkey projects, Eiffage Énergie Systèmes is in charge of design, construction, operation and maintenance for a two-year period.

Bertrand Genardini, Director of Solar Business Development at Eiffage Énergie Systèmes, adds: "Together, Eiffage Énergie Systèmes and Sunrock are reaffirming their commitment to renewable energies. These four projects represent the beginning of a shared adventure with the aim of supporting decarbonisation in logistics-sector companies in France."

The first installations are due for commissioning in early 2026.
